## Notes On Completion Of The Form

1. The Operator (Airline) is required to complete the form providing **ALL DETAILS** in BLOCK PRINT.
2. The completed application (original form) must be mailed to:

3. The Operator (Airline) must ensure that the goods are within the limitations of the Dangerous Goods Regulations and are packed, marked, labelled and documented in accordance with the Technical Instructions (ICAO Doc. 9284-AN/905).
4. Civil Aviation Affairs will forward the notification of their approval to the following:
  - (a) Operator (Airline) concerned
  - (b) Senior Chief of Customs (HCC)
  - (c) Bahrain Airport Services (BAS)
  - (d) Director of Airport, CAA (BAC)
  - (e) Director of Air Transport (DAT)

## Applicant Undertaking:

We undertake the following:

1. To train and maintain competency of personnel handling Dangerous Goods in accordance with the Dangerous Goods Provisions.
2. To ensure that the goods will be packed, marked, labelled and handled in accordance with ICAO Annex 18: Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air, and the requirements of the ICAO Technical Instructions Doc. 9284-AN/905.
3. To ensure that required Dangerous Goods Procedures, including Reporting of Accidents/Incidents, are complied with in accordance with CAA regulations and in CAP 02.

## Important Notes:

1. Applications for permission to carry arms, ammunition and explosives must be made separately for each consignment on the relevant CAA Form, and must be supported by the Ministry of Interior's Approval.
2. Applications for permission to carry and transport radioactive material must be made separately for each consignment on the relevant CAA Form ASED/DGR/FO-01 and sent to Bahrain CAA for approval.
