## Executive Summary

The air travel industry in the Kingdom of Bahrain continues to meet the local and international market demands, aligned with a distinctive aviation strategy to reinforce its leading position in the region.

Embarking, disembarking and transit passengers travelling through Bahrain International Airport reached nearly 8.5 million in 2017. Total aircraft movements touched 95,966 by the end of the year, with almost 8,000 flights a month. This number included both aircraft arrivals and departures, and connecting flights which totaled 56 destinations operated by 38 different airlines. Total Flight Information Region (FIR) movements reached 598,274, averaging 49,856 flights per month.

During 2017, total Cargo and Mail experienced an impressive growth with an increase of 10% as compared to 2016. This growth is reflected in the total tonnes transported, both in cargo as well as mail, which reached approximately 289,331 tonnes handled at the airport. Total cargo and mail transshipment increased by 13%, carrying the bulk of this weight in 2017 at almost 52,981 tonnes of cargo transshipment, and 437 tonnes of mail.

In addition to cargo growth, there was an increase in fuel usage by 3%, resting at approximately 148,000,000 US gallons.

# Definitions

## PASSENGERS

### Arriving Passengers (Arrivals):

All passengers who land at an airport and pass through immigration.

### Departing Passengers (Departures):

All passengers who pass through immigration prior to departure from the airport.

### Disembarking Passengers:

All passengers who disembark from an aircraft including transfer passengers but excluding transit.

### Embarking Passengers:

All passengers who board an aircraft including those who have transferred from other aircraft, but excluding transit.

### Transfer Passengers:

Passengers flying into and out of an airport on different aircraft, or on the same aircraft in which they arrived bearing the same aircraft registration and different flight numbers.

### Total Passengers:

All passengers - arrivals / departures / transit; i.e. all disembarking / embarking and transit.

## FREIGHT

### Mail:

Is the weight of letter mail carried.

### Cargo:

Is a flight carrying solely freight and / or mail and associated cargo attendants.

## MOVEMENTS

### Aircraft movements:

An aircraft take-off or landing at an airport. For airport purpose, one arrival and one departure are counted as two movements.

### Commercial movements:

Landing or take-off of aircraft engaged in the transport of passengers, cargo or mail on commercial terms.

### Private movements:

Movements for purely non-commercial purposes by private owners or other private aircraft operators.

### Others:

Movements for military and other purposes. Excluding passengers, cargo and private.

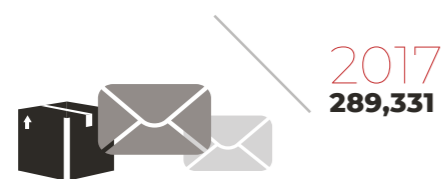

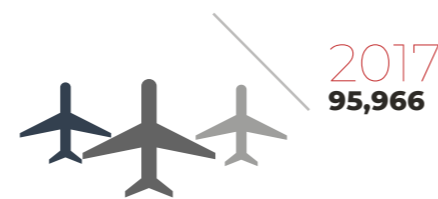
Total Passenger Movements

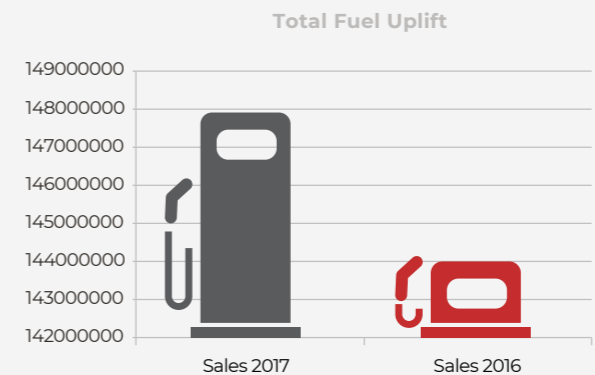

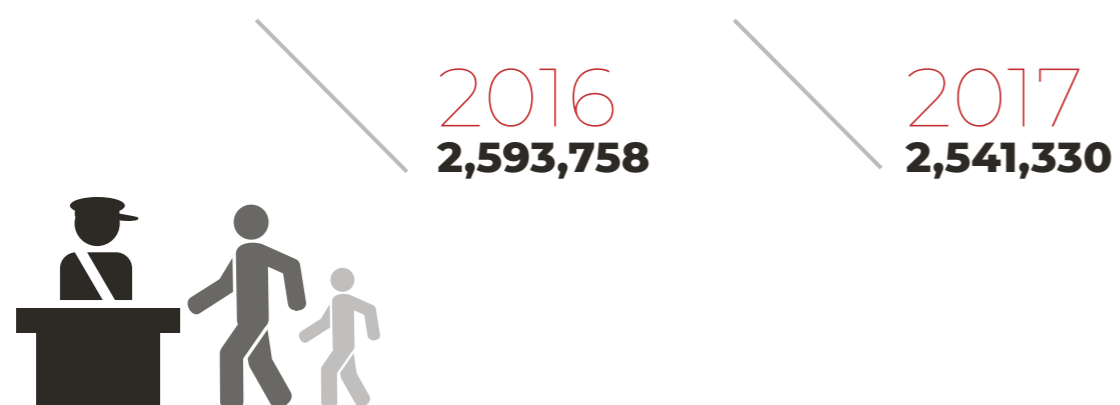

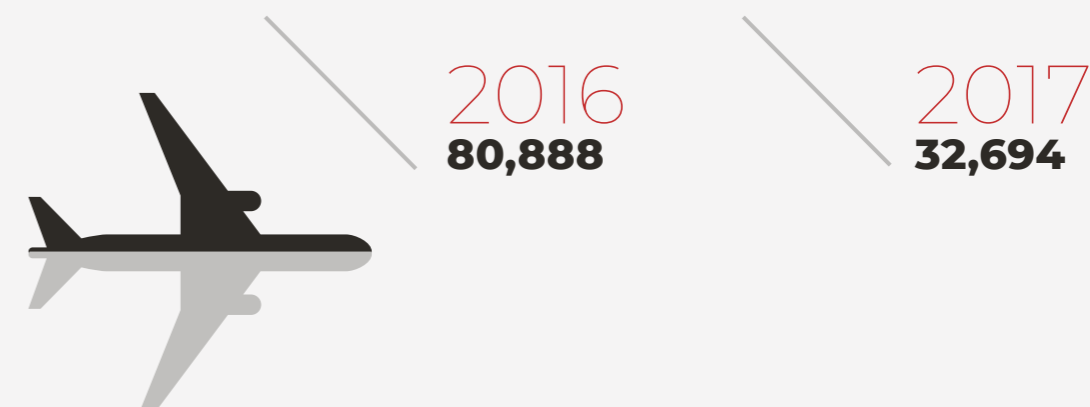

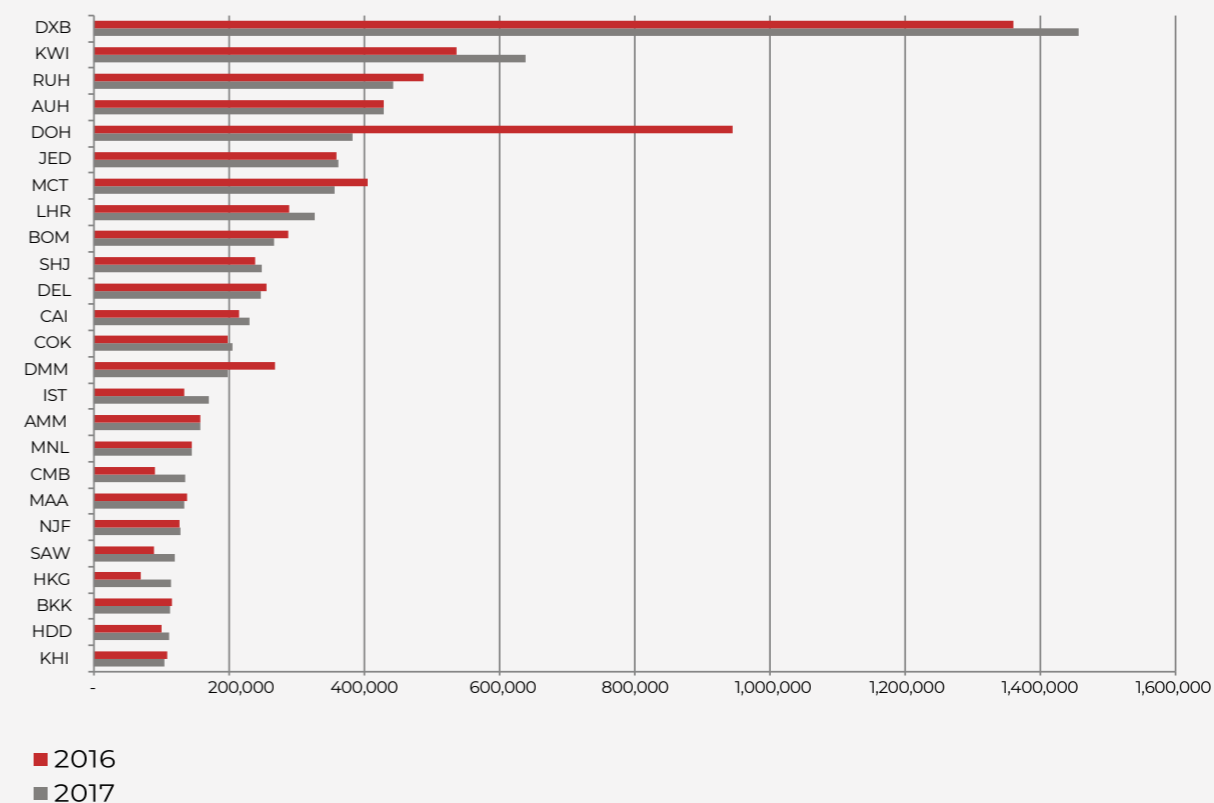

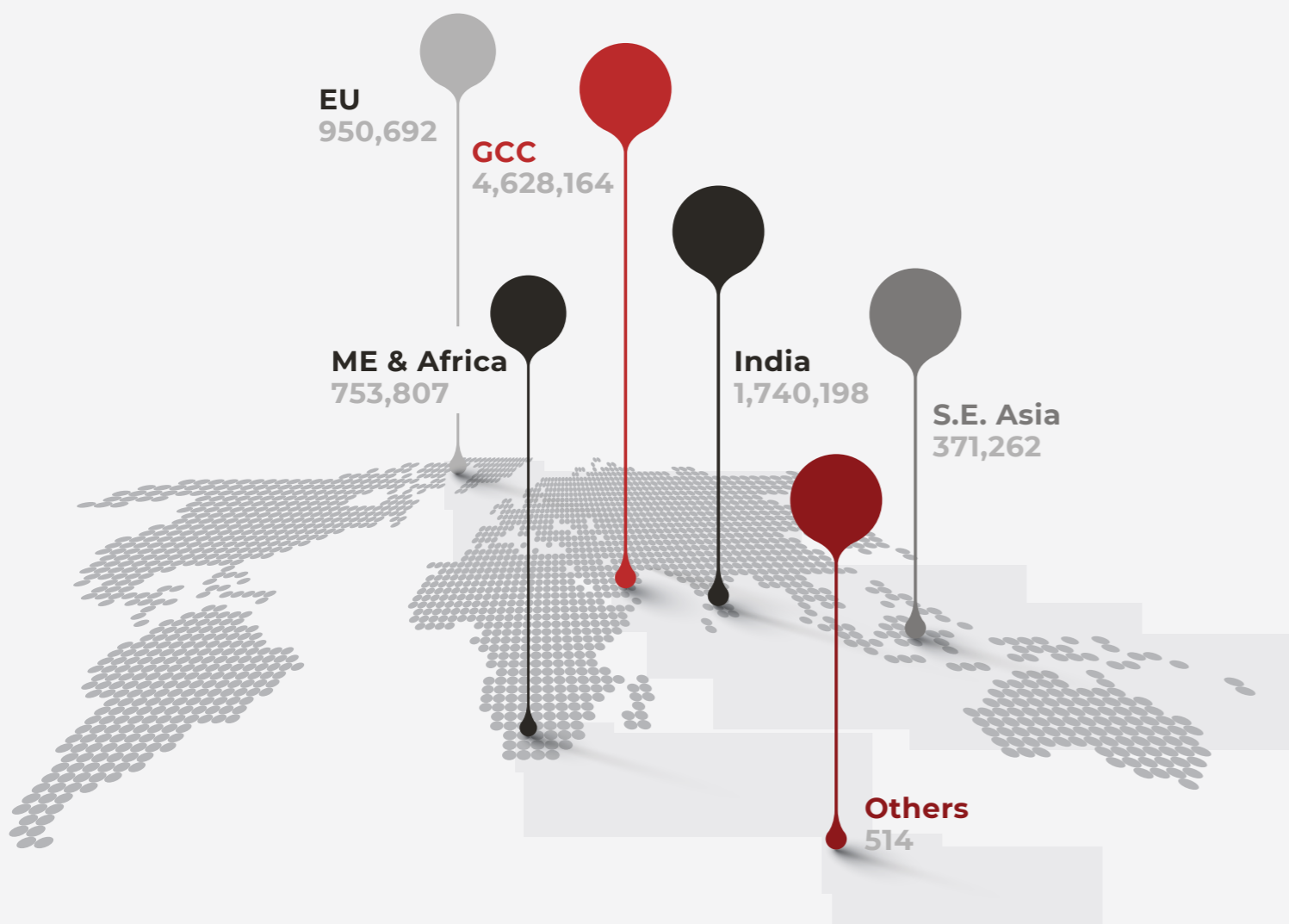

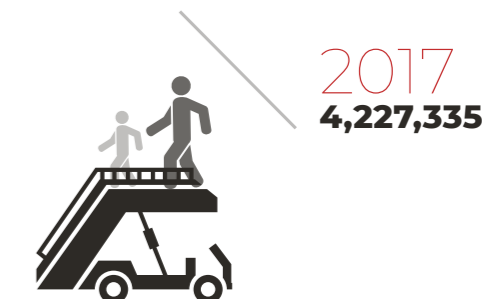

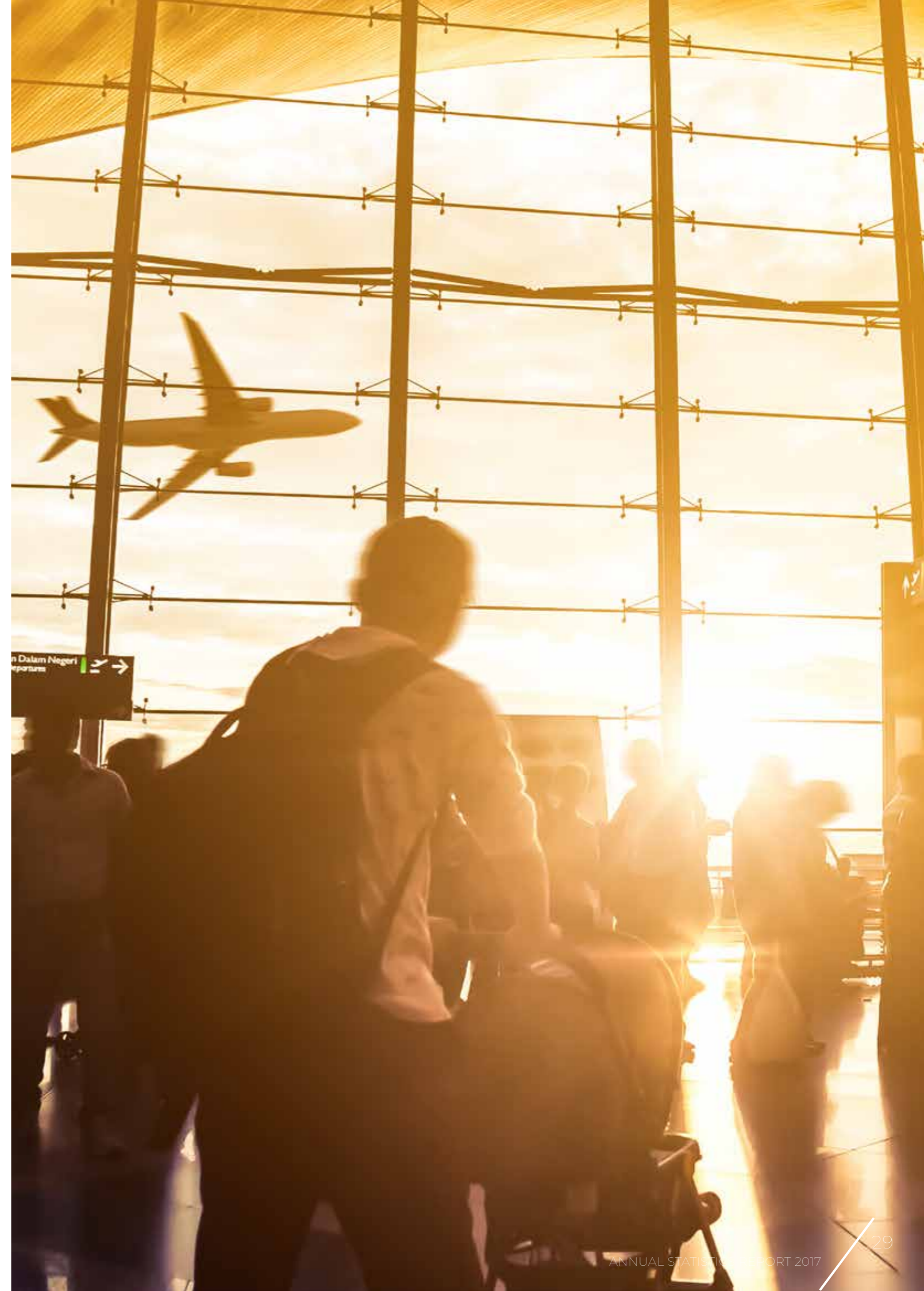

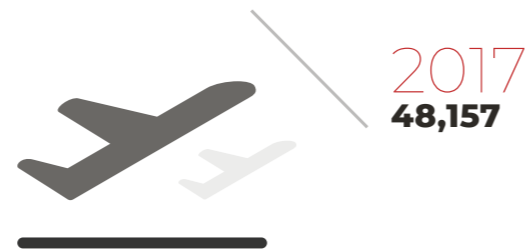

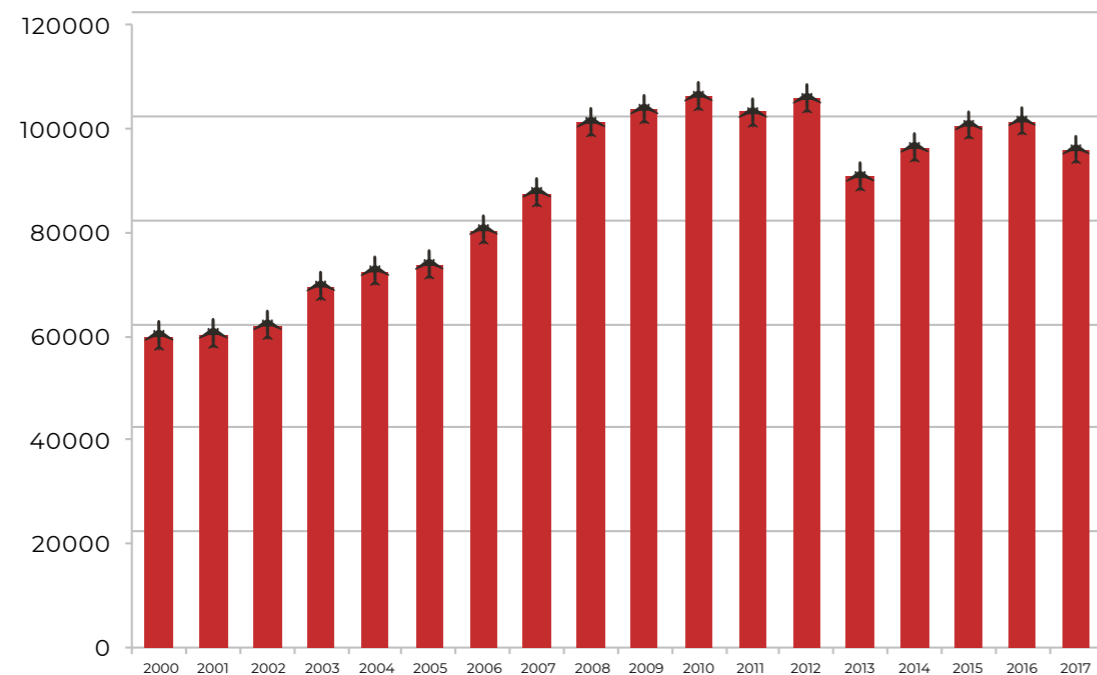

## Total Aircraft Movements (2017 - 2000)



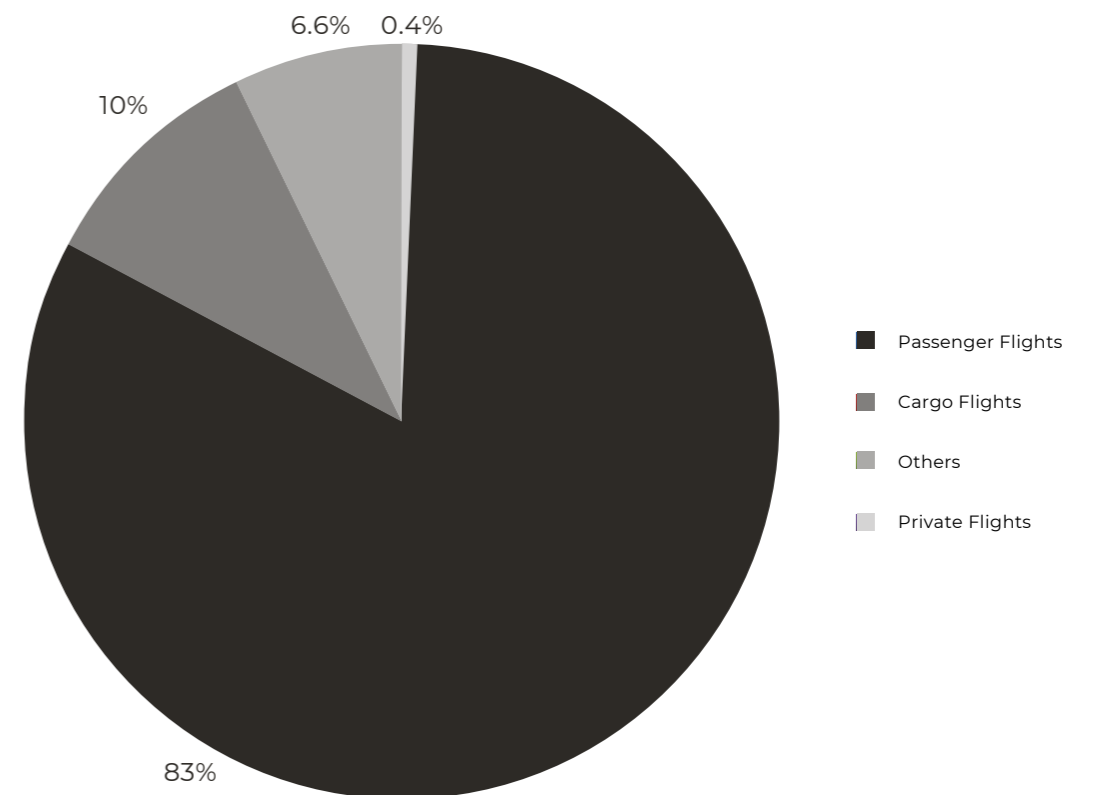

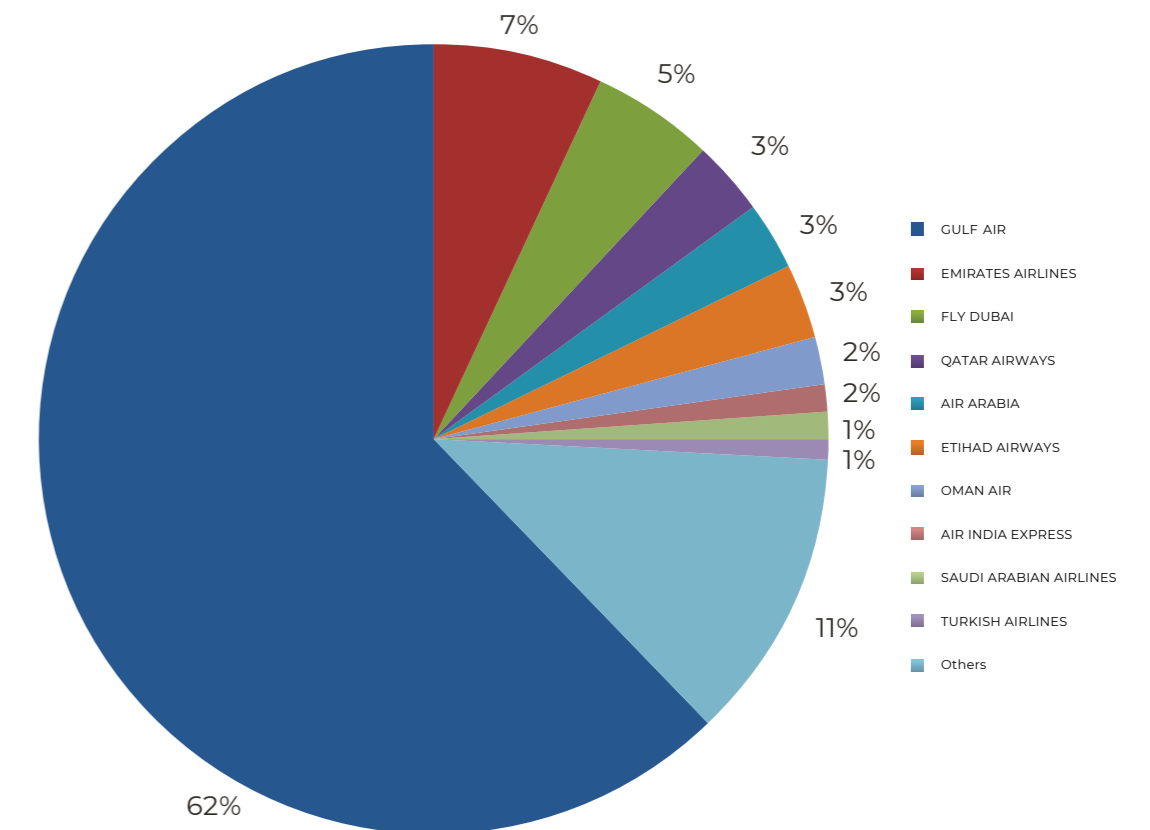

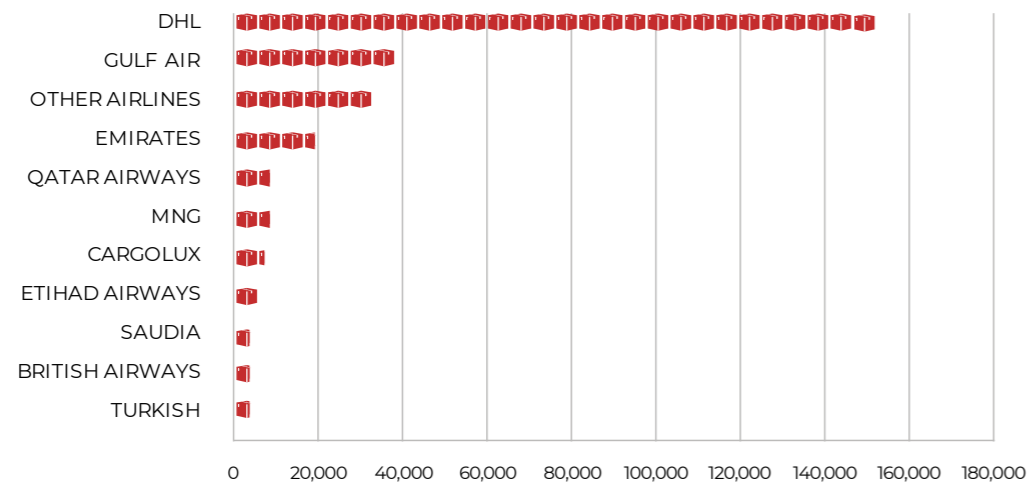

Bahraini citizens covered the majority of the movements with 28%, followed by 19% of Indian citizens and 11% Saudi Arabian citizens.

## Total Passengers Through Immigration by Nationality 2017

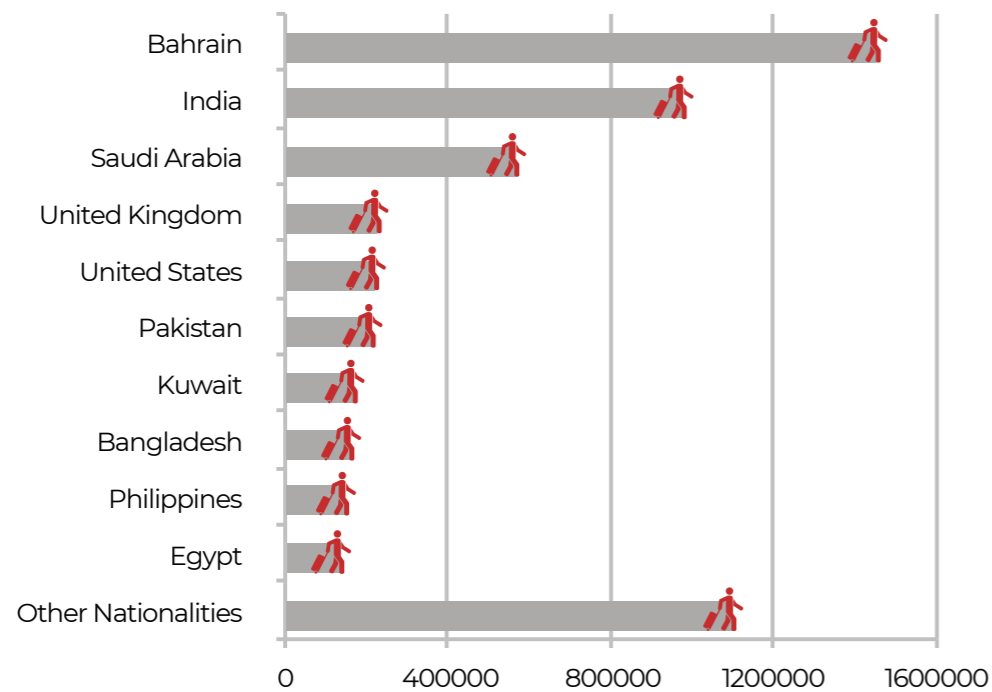
