ANTR OPS 1.020 LAWS, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES – OPERATOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Applicability:

Bahraini Aircraft Operators

Requirements:

It is hereby directed that all operators are required to comply with the changes enumerated below, as the state's obligation to show compliance to the latest ICAO Annex-6, Part I. Thus, the Annex Ops 1, Regulation at ANTR OPS 1.020 be read as follows:

ANTR OPS 1.020 Laws, Regulations and Procedures – Operator's Responsibilities

- (a) The operator must ensure that:
- (1) All employees are made aware that they shall comply with the laws, regulations and procedures of those States in which operations are conducted; and
 - (2) All crew members are familiar with the laws, regulations and procedures pertinent to the performance of their duties; prescribed for the areas to be traversed, the aerodromes to be used and the air navigation facilities relating thereto.
 - (3) The operator shall ensure that other members of the flight crew are familiar with such of these laws, regulations and procedures as are pertinent to the performance of their respective duties in the operation of the aeroplane.

Note: Information for pilots and flight operations personnel on flight procedure is contained in PANS-OPS (Doc 8168), Volume I. Criteria for the construction of visual and instrument flight procedures are contained in PANS-OPS (Doc 8168), Volume II. Procedure for Aircraft Operation are contained in PAN-OPS (DOC 8168), Volume III. Obstacle clearance criteria and procedures used in certain States may differ from PANS-

OPS, and knowledge of these differences is important for safety reasons.

---rest of the referred regulation remains unchanged.

Until such time the ANTR Part 4 (ANTR-OPS 1) is amended to apply this revision, all operators are required to comply with this AC with immediate effect.
