ADVISORY FOR FLIGHTS OPERATING to the UKRAINIAN AIRSPACE

EFFECTIVE DATE: 24th February 2022

APPLICABILITY:

All Bahraini registered aircraft operated by Bahraini civil operators.

PURPOSE:

This Circular is issued to advise Bahraini civil operators to exercise extreme caution operating in or close to Ukrainian airspace.

REQUIREMENTS:

Due to the resent observed military activities within Ukraine in eastern Europe, Bahrain Civil Aviation Affairs is issuing the Circular to advise Bahraini Civil Aviation operators to carry out due diligence and exercise extreme caution with regards to Flight operations in overflying airspaces or landing at airports associated with these conflicts. Operators are required to monitor closely NOTAMS issued relevant to this conflict and develop appropriate risk assessment required with rerouting into alternative airspaces.

This advisory is effective from 24th February 2022, until further notice.
