Staff unsure of their authority to release/transmit information that could relate to safety or security matters at BIA should consult their manager.</p> <p>3. Contravention of this Directive will be dealt with to the fullest extent of the law, and may result in termination of employment and/or judicial penalty.</p> <p>4.
