### Safety Directive (SD)

<b>Subject: New Radio Communication System at Bahrain International Airport</b>	<b>Directive No 6/2020</b> <b>Issued Date: 15 October 2020</b>
<p><b>1.Authority:</b> This Safety Directive is issued by the Undersecretary for Civil Aviation Affairs under the provisions of Article (s)5, 7,23 and 30 of Bahrain Civil Aviation Law No.14 of 2013.</p> <p><b>2.Purpose:</b> 2.1 The purpose of this Safety Directive is to notify all ground operational stakeholders at Bahrain International Airport (BIA) of the mandatory use of the New Two-Way Radio Communication (Huawei e-LTE) System. 2.2 The purpose of the system is to provide a reliable communication platform that can ensure safe operations and optimal coordination across wide groups of users at BIA.</p> <p><b>3.Applicability:</b> This Safety Directive is applicable to all stakeholders involved in ground operations at BIA.</p> <p><b>4.Directive:</b> To ensure operational safety, all BIA ground operational stakeholders are required to use the new Huawei e-LTE solution provided by Bahrain Airport Company (BAC) as the main two-way radio communication system at BIA.</p> <p><b>5. Effective Date:</b> This Directive shall come into force on 15 December 2020 and shall supersedes and cancels all prior directives and instructions relating to the use of mobile radio communication at BIA.</p>
